

Hello,

Construction on the I-89 Culvert Replacement project in Georgia will resume next week, April 24. Contractor J. A. McDonald's subcontractor, Bradshaw Construction Corporation, will mobilize equipment and personnel, survey the site and monitor settling. It will take two weeks to be ready to start tunneling for the new I-89 Southbound culvert that will be located about 40 feet below the highway.

There will be no lane closures during peak travel hours (6 AM-10 AM Southbound, 2:00-8:00 PM Northbound). There will be potential one-lane travel at other times.

**PLEASE DRIVE WITH CAUTION THROUGH THE WORK ZONE BY OBSERVING THE REDUCED 55 MPH POSTED SPEED LIMIT AND "HANDS FREE" IF USING A CELL PHONE.**
