

**Construction Update SO BURLINGTON I-89 Culverts Project – Week of June 5, 2017**

Hello,

Construction of two new culverts under I-89 between Exits 12 and 13 in So Burlington will enter a new phase next week. Starting Monday night (weather permitting) or Tuesday, lane shifts that will allow traffic to flow while the highway is dug up and new culverts are installed will be put into effect.

The lane shifts will be opened in the early hours of the morning. A rolling road block will be used. This will cause a minor delay in traffic, though traffic is expected to be very light.

Two lanes will be open to travelers while work is going on during the day but, for the safety of workers and motorists, the speed limit has been reduced to 55 m.p.h. for the duration of the project. Vermont State Police will step up enforcement to encourage motorists to slow down so our crew can work in a safe construction zone.
