

Construction Update So Burlington I-89 Culverts Project Week of May 22, 2017

Hello,

Construction of two diversions (2-lane temporary roadway) within the I-89 median between Exits 12 and 13 in So Burlington that will allow traffic to flow while the highway is dug up and new culverts are installed is in the final stages. The roadbed for the diversions has been formed and will be paved on Monday night, May 22. The diversion will be opened the evening of May 31.

Construction of the diversions will occur at night. Travel will be affected while the median diversions are built as follows:

- One-lane travel northbound – 8 PM to 6 AM (Sundays – Thursday)
- One-lane travel southbound – intermittently in the area near construction only to enable trucks to enter the highway

While the construction site will be very active at night, some construction tasks will occur during the day, especially surveying. The speed limit has been reduced to 55 m.p.h. for the duration of the project. Vermont State Police will step up enforcement to encourage motorists to slow down so our crew can work in a safe construction zone.
