

Hello,

This week signs are being installed in the Greater Burlington area as a “Smart Work Zone” warning system to alert motorists about an upcoming culvert replacement project on I-89. Two sets of culverts (four drainage pipes) located one mile apart between I-89 exits 12 and 13 will be replaced this year.

The evening of April 16, the contractor will begin constructing two diversions within the median that will allow traffic to flow while the highway is dug up and new culverts are installed. It will take about one month to complete building new roadway in the median. Construction of the diversions will occur at night. Travel will be reduced to one lane while the median are built.
