

Construction Update SO BURLINGTON I-89 Culverts – week of June 19

Hello,

Construction activities for an I-89 culverts project between Exits 12 and 13 Northbound in So Burlington will be transitioning next week. A lane shift to allow traffic to flow unimpeded while the highway is excavated for the installation of two culverts has been partially put into service. The culverts are located about one mile apart, with the southern culvert situated close to the whale tails area.

The construction crew will work days and nights until the lane shift work is totally completed. For the safety of workers and motorists, the speed limit has been reduced to 55 m.p.h. for the duration of the project. Vermont State Police will step up enforcement to encourage motorists to slow down so our crew can work in a safe construction zone.
